*How Does a Medicare  
Patient Qualify?*



Be entitled to Medicare Part A.

Meet a three-day prior in-patient hospital stay requirement.

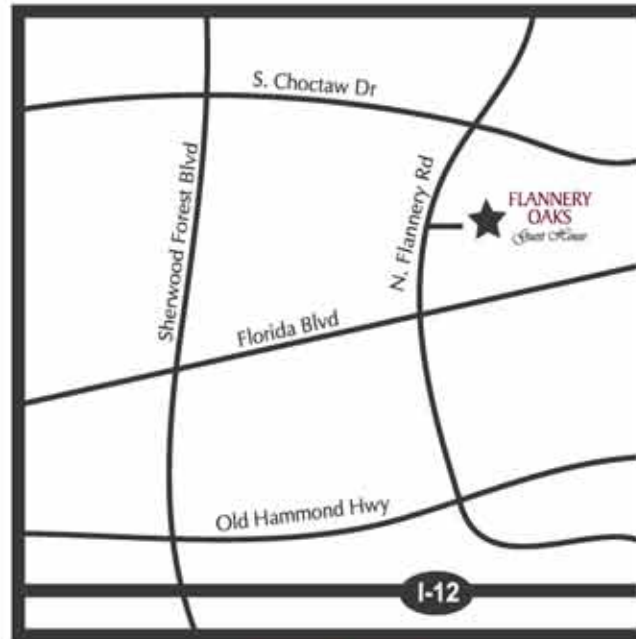
Be admitted to a skilled facility within 30 days after being discharged from a hospital.

Require skilled nursing services and/or skilled rehabilitative services on a daily basis.  
(rehab must be five days per week)

Have days available in the current benefit period.
